Rule of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle:

- The lottery will take place during the Kingston Frontenac's Hockey games at Rogers K-ROCK CENTRE, Kingston ON
- 2. All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
- 3. Tickets are \$20.00 for 60.
- 4. Tickets will be available at various kiosk throughout the building at the ROGERS K-ROCK CENTRE, 1 The Tragically Hip Way, Kingston ON.
- 5. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by the Kingston Frontenac's.
- 6. After Buying patrons will be given by the sellers, a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
- 7. The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw for that day/game.
- 8. The amount of the 50/50 will be announced prior to announcing the winning number in the 3rd period of play.
- 9. The winning number will be announced at the whistle stop after it has been selected, in the 3rd period of the hockey game.
- 10. If the patron with the winning number on their ticket is at the game where the number has been drawn, they may come to the 50/50 table on the 300-level concourse, above section 114.
- 11. If the winner is not in attendance at the game, or does not wish to claim their prize immediately, they may claim their prize by contacting Mr. Marilyn Eimers through the Kingston Frontenac's @ 613 542 4042. The ticket may then be brought to the Kingston Frontenac's Office at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. The winner will then be paid by cheque for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket. *All payments will be made by cheque*.
- 12. The winning ticket holder has *6 months* in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.
- 13. The winner must provide his/her address and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet.
- 14. If no winner comes forward the number will be announced repeatedly over the PA system, and posted on the Kingston Frontenac's Website and inside Rogers K-ROCK CENTRE.
- 15. At subsequent events, the number will be posted at each selling station.
- 16. If no winner comes forward, the winning stub will be kept in a safety deposit box and held for 6 months. After that period, the prize will be split between the four Minor Hockey associations with beneficiary agreements with AGCO for the Kingston Frontenac's 50/50 draws.

- 17. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draws. Staff of the Kingston Frontenac's or ticket-sellers for the event.
- 18. The above set of rules will be posted at each event.
