1. Coaches of House League/Local League/ Minor Development / Rostered Select in divisions below Novice (Initiation & Tyke) **must** hold Coach 1-Intro to Coach qualification - No other qualifications are accepted
2. Coach 2-Coach Level 'Trained' or higher: Coach 2-Coach Level 'Trained' or 'Certified'; Development 1 'Trained' or 'Certified'; High Performance 1 & 2 'Trained' or 'Certified'
3. Development 1 'Trained' or higher: Development 1 'Trained' or 'Certified' or; High Performance 1 & 2 'Trained' or 'Certified'
4. Development 1 'Certified' or higher: Development 1 'Certified' or; High Performance 1 & 2 'Trained' or 'Certified'
5. High Performance 1 'Certified' or higher: High Performance 1 & 2 'Certified'

### ADDITIONAL NOTES – HOUSE LEAGUE:

- Assistant Coaches at House League require Respect in Sport (RiS)-Activity Leader or Speak Out! only, however, they would require the appropriate qualification listed in chart above for participation with teams from outside their House League (i.e. exhibition and/or tournament play).
- In addition, if the Head Coach were not available to start a House League game, an appropriately qualified NCCP Coach would be required to act as the Head Coach.



## Coaches Program • Revised NCCP for Hockey 2015-2016 Coaching Requirements

### Hockey Canada High Performance 1 | NCCP Competition Development

#### **Hockey Canada Policy:**

All Head Coaches coaching Male Bantam 'AAA' (Minor and Major), Female Bantam 'AA', Male Midget 'AAA' (Minor or Major), Female Midget 'AA' and Junior 'A' must be High Performance 1 **'Certified'** according to the Hockey Canada policy during the **2015-2016 season**, 2016-2017 season for Junior 'A'. It is recommended that all Assistant Coaches be a minimum Development 1 **'Trained'**.

Coaching Requirements meeting the Standards established by Hockey Canada and the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC):

#### 1. **Requirements by Role:**

Head Coaches – High Performance 1 (HP1) - 'Certified'

Assistant Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Trained'

#### 2. **Rostering Eligibility:**

- All Coaches must have **'Trained'** status to be added to a Team Roster
- Coaches requiring **'Certified'** status must complete certification process by:  
**August 31<sup>st</sup> of current season**

#### 3. **Certification Maintenance / Qualification Renewal:**

- High Performance 1 (HP1) 'Certified' status is valid for 5 years
- 30 Professional Development Points are required to renew certification
- High Performance 1 (HP1) 'Trained' status is valid for 5 years
- The development pathway for High Performance 1 (HP1) 'Trained' Coaches is to move through the certification process **or** after expiry must take clinic again

### Hockey Canada Development 1 | NCCP Competition Introduction

#### **Hockey Canada Policy:**

All Head Coaches, that coach teams in **Peewee or above** at **competitive levels**, as determined by the Branch, must be **Development 1 'Certified'** (other than those requiring High Performance 1). It is recommended that all **Assistant Coaches** have **Development 1 'Trained'** status.

Coaching Requirements meeting the Standards established by Hockey Canada and the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC):

#### 1. **Definition of 'Competitive Levels' per Hockey Canada Policy:**

Levels where there is an OHF Championship - **AAA, AA, A**

#### 2. **Requirements by Role:**

<b>AAA, AA, A:</b>	Head Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Certified' Assistant Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Trained'
<b>Rep Levels Below A:</b>	Head Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Trained' Assistant Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Trained'

#### 3. **Roster Eligibility:**

- All Coaches must have 'Trained' status to be added to a Team Roster
- Coaches requiring 'Certified' status must complete certification process by:  
**August 31<sup>st</sup> of current season**

#### 4. **Certification Maintenance / Qualification Renewal:**

- Development 1 (D1) 'Certified' status is valid for 5 years
- 20 Professional Development Points are required to renew certification
- Development 1 (D1) 'Trained' status is valid for 5 years
- The development pathway for Development 1 (D1) 'Trained' Coaches is to move through the certification process **or** after expiry must take clinic again
